




What is a project?

It's a **temporary** endeavour undertaken to create a **unique** product, service or result. (*Project Management Institute - PMI*)

A project is a unique, transient endeavour, undertaken to achieve planned objectives, which could be defined in terms of outputs, outcomes or benefits. (Association for Project Management - APM)








What is Project Management?

Project management is the application of knowledge, skills, tools and techniques to project activities to meet the project requirements. (PMI)

Code of Ethics & Professional Conduct (PMI): Responsibility, Respect, Fairness, Honesty




The Talent Triangle (PMI)

PM Knowledge Areas








Project: a journey

The journey begins with an idea....

- Business Plan
- Benefits management plan





Project Initiating

"...only projects that are aligned with the organizations strategic objectives are authorised". (PMBOK)

- Project Charter ("birth certificate")
- Identify Stakeholders

Stakeholders: "an individual, group, or organization, who may affect, be affected by, or perceive itself to be affected by a decision, activity, or outcome of a project". (PMI)





Project Planning

- "... to define the course of action to successfully complete the project". (PMBOK)
- Develop Project Management Plan (all knowledge areas)
- Scope Definition
- Project Schedule
- Project Budget
- Quality Management
- Risk Management







Project Executing

- "... the work needed to meet the project requirements and objectives is performed according to plan". (PMBOK)
- Direct and Manage Project Work
- Manage Project Knowledge





Project Monitor & Control

"... project performance is measured and analysed at regular intervals, appropriate events, or when exception condition occur in order to identify and correct variances from the project management plan". (PMBOK)

- Monitor and Control Project Work
- Perform Integrated Change Control





Project Closing

- "... projects (and contracts) are closed down appropriately". (PMBOK)
- Close Project
- Final project documents updates
- Final Report
- Celebrate! (for a successful project)
